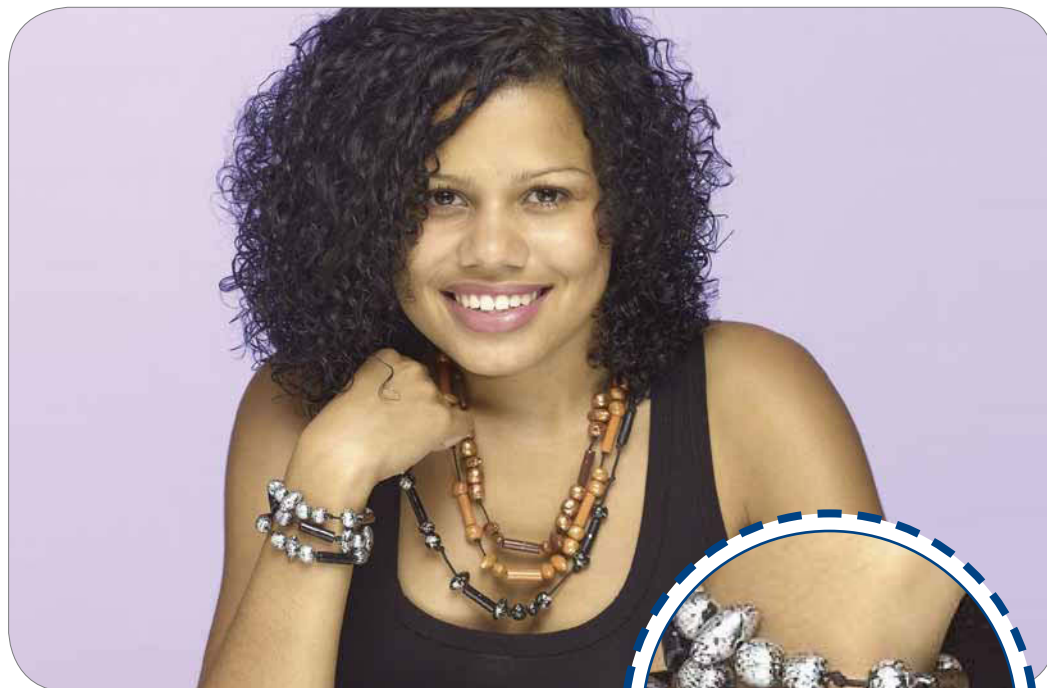

**You will also require:** leather or cotton cord, chain clasp (optional), smooth work surface (glass or ceramic), knitting needles or skewers

## Instructions for 1,2,3 New Look - hand-made...



Begin by cutting the FIMO into portions: Make an olive-shaped and a long-shaped bead using one quarter of a strip of FIMO for each. Shape small balls in your hands using an eighth of a strip of FIMO for each one.

Cut the ends off the long bead to make them straight. Create at least 20 different beads – preferably even more – with each colour.



Tear small bits off a sheet of leaf metal and place these on the beads.

Roll carefully in your hands until the leaf metal sticks to the surface of the FIMO and a crackle look is achieved.



Using a knitting needle, carefully make a hole in the beads. Suspend the needle with the beads between two glasses or cups and place in the oven.

This will help avoid any distortion caused by them being placed on a surface and ensure that the beads keep their shape. The hardening process takes 30 minutes at 110 °C.

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**Tip:**

Unfinished items and left-over bits of material can be stored in a sealed plastic bag or airtight container, e.g. a plastic box or jar.



To add an attractive shine to the finished necklace, apply a coat of gloss varnish after the beads have cooled down.

This will also protect the leaf metal and ensure it doesn't rub off when worn. Once they're dry, the beads can be strung onto a length of cord as required and kept in place with knots.
