**You will also require:** pencil and paper, a pair of scissors, ruler, ovenproof smooth work surface (glass or ceramic), different pen caps, sparkly stones in different sizes and colours, hair slide with a smooth surface, a sheet of blue-coloured art paper, Pattex MULTI all-purpose glue

## Instructions for Butterfly hair clip



Fold the paper down the middle and draw half of a butterfly on it, approx. 4 cm wide and 5 cm high. Cut out along the lines and open up so that you are left with a symmetrical-shaped butterfly template.

Roll out four strips of raspberry-coloured FIMO to an approx. 3mm thick sheet. Place the template on top and cut out around the outside. Then remove the paper and smooth over the edges of the FIMO butterfly using your fingers.



Make thin strings out of apple-green FIMO, position them carefully along the edges of the butterfly and press on gently. Cut off any excess FIMO and smooth over the joins.

Use peppermint-coloured FIMO to make the body and place it in the middle of the butterfly. Add grooves to it using the back of a knife.

Cut out thin slices of green and yellow FIMO using the pen caps, place them on the wings of the butterfly and press on gently.



Leaving the butterfly on the work surface, place it in the oven to harden for 30 minutes at 110°C. Once it has cooled down, stick the sparkly stones on. Don't forget the eyes! Varnish if required.

To make the feelers, cut thin strips out of the bluecoloured art paper and adhere them to the back of the head. Stick the finished butterfly onto the hair slide and allow everything to dry.

## Tip

Instead of making the paper template yourself, you could use a butterfly-shaped cutter, e.g. Noris Club plastic shaped cutters (8724).
